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## Contract extension for TransnetBW CEO Dr Werner Götz

STUTTGART, Germany - The Supervisory Board of TransnetBW has reappointed Dr Werner Götz as Chairman of the Executive Board. Götz has been a member of the Executive Board since 2015 and held its Chairmanship since 2017. The contract extension provides for a five-year term, meaning that Götz will remain at the helm of the Baden-Württemberg transmission system operator until 2025.

"TransnetBW will be implementing major energy transition projects in the years ahead," said Dr Hans-Josef Zimmer, Chairman of the Supervisory Board and Chief Technology Officer of EnBW AG. "This calls for an experienced and determined manager like Werner Götz." This continuity and industry expertise will also be crucial in light of the mounting challenges confronting TransnetBW's core mission: to provide a secure power supply for individuals, families and businesses at all times.

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## **ELECTRICITY / GRID / SECURITY**

As a transmission system operator headquartered in Stuttgart, we stand for the secure and reliable supply of roughly eleven million people in Baden-Württemberg. We ensure the operation, maintenance, planning and demand-based expansion of the transport grid of the future. Our 220 and 380 kV circuits are roughly 3,200 kilometres long, and our grid covers an area of 34,600 km². This is available to all players in the electricity market on a non-discriminatory basis as well as under transparent conditions that are in line with market conditions.

Our modern transmission grid is the backbone of a reliable energy supply in Baden-Württemberg and the foundation of a functioning economy and society.
